POSITION SUMMARY:

Responsible for setting up equipment and mixing sound to support music and speech for the worship ministries of Bethlehem Lutheran Church, and thereby enhancing the total worship experience for all.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE POSITION:

Set up microphones, run cords, and mix sound during practices, worship services, and approved concerts or special events.

Work with musicians and pastors to achieve the optimum sound to enhance events.

Coordinate scheduling with Assistant Sound Technician(s) to ensure that all rehearsals and worship times as outlined in the hours section below are covered every week. Report any problems with coverage to the Coordinator for Contemporary Music.

ADDITIONAL DUTIES:

Occasionally, Bethlehem has requests for a sound technician to staff weddings, outside concerts, and other special events*. The Sound Technician may be contacted for such events but is not obligated to take on these additional responsibilities. The group or family will pay compensation directly to the Sound Technician.

REPORTING RELATIONSHIP:

The Sound Technician's immediate supervisor is the Coordinator for Contemporary Music.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Knowledge and skills for running soundboards and setting up equipment to achieve a pleasing and balanced musical sound and spoken word, which enhances the worship experience for all worshippers.

Commitment to the vision & mission of Bethlehem Lutheran Church.

Thursday Rehearsal 7:00 – 8:30 p.m. (2 Thursdays per month)

9:30 – 11:45 a.m. summer hours
