- Sunday School Coordinator/Runner:** Troubleshoots teacher needs on Sundays (copies, supplies) Maintains Bulletin Board, other duties as needed
- Sunday School Teacher *56 Teacher:** Using curriculum guides, will plan and facilitate 35 minute lessons. Lessons include Bible stories and activity options. Teachers will stay with the same class all year to establish strong relationships. Materials will be provided as needed. Teachers must attend training sessions.

- Mystery Mission:** Help coordinate 4 service projects/events during the year. This is a program for 5th and 6th graders.
- Music Leader:** Teach songs and/or accompany Sunday School students on piano or guitar during the Sunday School hour. _____ Sunday _____ Wednesday
- Substitute:** Fill in for Teachers or Assistant Coordinator when they are unable to be here. This could be either a pre-planned situation or last minute circumstances. You will be expected to sub one Sunday per month.
- Sunday School Set Up-** Unlock preschool doors, set up any tech support needed, pass out papers.
- Sunday School Clean Up-** Go through Sunday School rooms and make sure all papers are thrown away and supplies are neatly put away.
- Acolyte Coordinator:** Do weekly reminder calls and e-mails to those assigned to Acolyte.
- Special Projects at home:** Be called upon to occasionally to provide administrative support from home. Tasks may include creating artwork, contacting families by phone, creating name tags or thank you gifts for teachers..
- Special Events Team:** Assist coordinator in planning and executing special events such as Rally Sunday, Palm Sunday, and Milestone set up.
- Infant Toddler Center:** Assist the ITC Coordinator on Sunday mornings during the 9:00 or 11:00 service or during special events. Duties include caring for children 0-3 years of age.
- Worship Bags:** Clean out and restock bags used by our youngest worshippers once a month.
- Communications:** Assist the Discipleship Team in contacting students/parents about upcoming events or recruiting parent partners by phone.
- Chaperone for Retreats:** Bethlehem currently schedules one confirmation retreat for each grade (7th - 9th); a LEAPP Frog Training retreat; and other events where adults are needed. Sometimes these adults are involved in programming; at other events they are simply guides to help maintain focus for a group. Picture yourself leading discussions, snow tubing with students preparing meals or campfires, etc.
- Confirmation Guide:** Mentor and lead youth in grades 7-9 through their confirmation experience using small group discussion and group building activities. Lesson preparation will be done by a staff member. Confirmation groups meet from September - May on Wednesdays 6:30 - 8:00 pm. Would like guides to consider a 3 year commitment.
- Substitute Confirmation Guide:** Be available to step up at the last minute to fill in for Guides in times of crisis, sickness, or planned absence.
- Confirmation Support:** Assist with projects, supplies and snacks for confirmation
